The University of Haifa is proposing the construction of a pedestrian bridge that will provide a safe overpass from the main highway surrounding the University to the campus entrance. The proposed bridge will afford access for hundreds of students who are at risk every day when crossing this busy highway to attend classes at the University.

This alarming safety issue requires immediate attention and has already taken a heavy toll: a student recently crossing this road was tragically injured and left permanently paralyzed.
